

# Scarecrow, Scarecrow

## WHAT THEY LEARN

Following directions, gross motor movement, steady beat, rhyming

## WHAT YOU NEED

- Scarecrow visual (optional)
- Scarecrow, Scarecrow Audio Track (optional)

## WHAT TO DO

- Show the class the visual of the scarecrow or bring in a real scarecrow!
- Have the children stand in their places, and ask them to follow the scarecrow. Start the chant (or sing it!) at a slow and steady pace so they can keep up with the motions.
- When you get to the end, tell the little scarecrows “night-night”.
- After a brief pause, wake them up to do it again or to do the next activity.

## LYRICS

Tune: “Teddy Bear, Teddy Bear”

Scarecrow, Scarecrow, turn around.  
Scarecrow, scarecrow, touch the ground (or jump up and down)  
Scarecrow, scarecrow, reach up high  
Scarecrow, Scarecrow, wink one eye
